CD’s are available of the A.M. Service. Pls. see Lori Jorgenson for a copy.

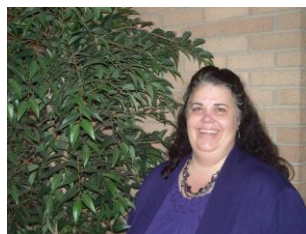
The A.M. Worship Service is also streaming live on the TV monitor in the Church Library and is available on the church website early in the week.
